The Etiwanda Rangeland Ready White Dorper ram sale was also supported strongly by return clients and a very pleasing crowd of new bidders on site. A crowd of about 70 attended the sale, with 28 bidders on Auctionsplus.

The 73, 7 month old, LambPlan recorded White Dorper rams averaged \$1780.00/head, up \$385.00 on last year's sale, and buyers travelled from Tilpa, Bourke, Guyra, Dubbo, Nyngan, Cobar, Hillston, Tottenham, Cunnamulla and Eulo in QLD, to access the Etiwanda



genetics. The top priced ram sold to James Mead of Warwick in QLD for \$2900.00, a beautiful clean coated ram with a balanced set of ASBV's.

The 12 flock rams, sold in pens of 2, averaged \$1283.00/head and were also keenly sought after.
